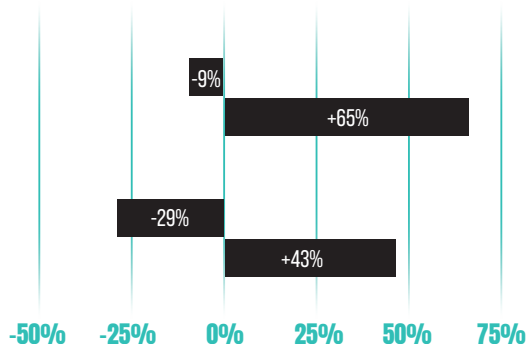

50% increase in both liver cases and deaths from liver cancer expected by 2040

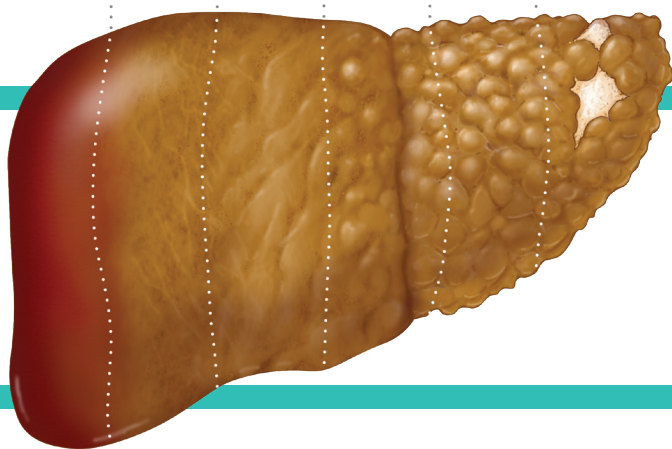
LIVER CANCER IS ONE OF THE DEADLIEST CANCERS

22% survival rate after five years

THE LINKAGE

- As many as **25%** of those with fatty liver (MASLD/NAFLD) will progress to advanced liver disease (MASH/NASH)
- **~60%** of cirrhosis cases come from MASH/NASH
- **More than 80%** of hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC) cases develop from cirrhosis
- **More than 80%** of liver cancer cases are HCC

WHAT IS HEPATOCELLULAR CARCINOMA?

HCC is a cancer that starts in hepatocyte cells, which are the main functional cells in the liver.

HCC is different from "secondary" liver cancers, which have spread to the liver from other organs.
